## HEADMASTER'S REPORT

During the past year, considerable progress has been made with the material improvements needed for the school's outdoor activities. The playing-field itself has been in full use, and the space available increased by the demolition of a derelict building; although the summer drought following a wet winter has left it in a poor condition from which recovery will be difficult. Building of the pavilion and changing-rooms began in April, and they will be completed and in use in the near future, together with two fives courts. We are regularly using two additional Rugby pitches at the Old Rutlishians' ground; and we were also able to arrange for the use of tennis courts there during the summer term. Plans are well advanced for the new Cadet Force building at the side of the field.

Cricket especially prospered in the fine weather this year. But I should also like to record our pleasure at the award of a Rugby Blue to P. R. Mills, who played for Cambridge last December.

A large number of parents visited the school on the occasion of the Open Day on July 11th, when the demonstrations in the Science Department in particular were much appreciated. During the year we had our first school plays on the new stage; and there were two concerts, of which the second, in July, was probably the most successful the orchestra has yet given.

Two parties have visited places abroad; and it will be noted that a number of senior boys made use of the John Innes Travel Scholarships.

The examination results recorded below show that a very satisfactory standard is being maintained at the Advanced Level, with the emphasis, numerically at least, on the Maths and Science side. There is a danger, however, that something may be lost by a too narrow concentration of effort by those boys who cannot stay for a third year in the Sixth Form.

Four members of the Staff left us last year for other appointments: Mr. Walton, Mr. Sharpe, Mr. Denning and Mr. Whitton. We welcome as newcomers Mr. Ward, Mr. Playfair, Mr. Glass, Mr. Adams, Mr. Palmer and Mr. Clothier.

I should like to express our appreciation for the continued support and material help of the Old Rutlishians' and Parents' Associations, and in particular for the contribution of both to the prize fund.
