## HEADMASTER'S REPORT

In the past year we have seen with much satisfaction the completion of the new buildings on the field. The Pavilion and changing rooms were opened by Mr. Wilfrid Wooler in January. Later in the term the new Cadet Force headquarters was opened, a ceremony by which the School contingent celebrated the Cadet Force Centenary year. In this connection, representatives of the contingent attended a special parade at Buckingham Palace in July. Finally, Mrs. Varnish came to open the Fives Courts which were erected as a memorial to her late husband, the former Headmaster. Many old boys attended on that occasion.

Scholastic successes achieved during the year include four State Scholarships on the results of this year's examinations, and the award to J. B. Hall last December of an open exhibition at Oxford. This year more sixth-formers than usual are staying on for an additional year; and more than ever before of last year's fifth form have started on the various Advanced courses.

A considerable number of boys who had only limited success at the Ordinary level have also come back to take or re-take subjects. It will probably be the last time that we can accommodate candidates for a second year in the fifth form, as the numbers coming up the school completely fill our accommodation. It is for every boy due to take the examination to make the utmost of his opportunity, and not rely on the possibility of a second attempt.

We have again had most successful tours abroad; and other expeditions in Britain, in addition to the camps and arduous training exercises run by the C.C.F.

Plays and orchestral concerts have again been carried through with success, and have been appreciated by the audiences.

I have to acknowledge again most gratefully the help afforded by the Parents' Association and the Old Rutlishians.
